- 1) The Bentley Drivers Club will organise a Race Meeting on Saturday ~~9~~**15**th August 2025, on the 1.639-mile, National Circuit, at Silverstone, Towcester, Northamptonshire, NN12 8TN.
- 2) The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any ASR's or written instructions the organising club may issue for the event. Please read Final Instructions or subsequent bulletins issued to you for these events.

Using **2026** National Competition Rules ~~V9~~ ('NCR').

- 3) The Club is a registered with Motorsport UK (Club ID 120786).

Motorsport UK Permit Number: **208071** Grade: Interclub.

- 4) Drivers and Entrant Drivers must be members of the BDC or other invited clubs, must be registered for any Championship/Series and must be in possession of a valid Motorsport UK Race licence of "**Race Interclub**" or Higher unless otherwise notified on Championship/Series Regulations, or be in possession of the highest grade of National Race Licence or valid FIA International Licence, together with their ASN's written consent (Ch.6 App.3 Art.1 (6.3.1) and FIA ISC Article 2.3.7.b applies). ~~(Should a competitor possess a licence which would necessitate the event being inscribed on the Motorsport UK "National Competition with Authorised Foreign Participation" Calendar, the BDC will inscribe the event subject to agreement by the Motorsport UK and payment of the appropriate fee by that competitor. Any entry by a competitor not possessing a Motorsport UK Race Licence will not be deemed to have been accepted until such time as proof has been provided by the Competitor's ASN that that competitor is authorised to participate in the event as required under Article 18 of the International Sporting Code).~~

- 5) The event is open to all fully elected Members of the Bentley Drivers Club and Members of the following Clubs:

- 6) All documentation required for this event will be via electronic means, an e-mail address will be required for all correspondence.
- 7) The opening date is on publication of these Supplementary Regulations. The closing date is ~~Wednesday 30th July at 17:00.~~ **Friday 7th August 2026 at 17:00.** Entries can only be made via the **ON-LINE** entry system. In addition to ~~National Competition Rules V9 ('NCR')~~, Ch.3 App.5 Art.8 (3.5.8) & Ch.3 App.5 Art.9 (3.5.9), the organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry at their discretion. Acknowledgement of submission will be by automatic return e-mail. The Entry will either be accepted, refused, or deferred, within seven days of receipt, up to the closing date, as per the ~~National Competition Rules V9 ('NCR')~~. and will be sent via email.

- 8) By entering this meeting, you are acknowledging that you have read and understood ~~the National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'), Supplementary Regulations, and any specific requirements as issued.
- 9) Admission to the Venue will be by personnel passes, each Competitor will receive 4 passes per event entered, including second drivers, Vehicle passes may be issued if required. Personal passes may be sent via e-mail or may be issued through the Silverstone Ticketing App with instructions on how to download them.
- 10) The maximum entry for each race is 40, the minimum is 10. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the meeting, or amalgamate races, or classes, as necessary.
- 11) Full refunds will be given if the Secretary of the Meeting is notified by 12:00 noon on Wednesday ~~6th~~ **12th** August. Nominated reserves that do not get a race may be considered for a full refund.
- 12) In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the meeting the organisers may retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
- 13) ~~Signing on for all races will be advised in the Final Instructions.~~ **Signing on is included in the on-line Entry form so you will not be required to Sign on at the meeting.**
- 14) Scrutineering for all races will be advised in the Final Instructions.
- 15) Each competitor will be given the opportunity to qualify as per the ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'). Starting positions will be in accordance with qualifying times, except for the second Morgan Challenge Race which will be the finishing order of the first race.
- 16) In the case of races in which the Handicap is wholly or partly based on qualifying times, a driver who improves upon his best qualifying lap time by more than 5% may be excluded as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR').
- 17) A change of car or driver(s) from those nominated in the Official Programme of the event on written application being made by the Driver/Entrant not less than half an hour before the start of practice or competition (where there is no practice) and provided that: (a) A change of only one or the other and not both is permitted, unless all the Drivers/Entrants agree in writing to such a change of both and; (b) No change of car is permitted which would prevent the participation in the event of a reserve entry.

- 19) Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each Qualifying Session and Race and will be forwarded to each competitor via electronic means and posted on the "Virtual Notice Board."
- 20) Protests: Any protests must be made in accordance as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR').

21) Events, Awards & Entry Fee: There will be 7 Events, as follows, the Race order will be indicated in the Final Instructions.

Event 1. The Bentley Scratch Race & The Pre-War Race

Qualifying Time: 15Min, Race Distance: 10Laps, Entry Fee: ~~£325~~ £340

Must be a BDC Member, driving a Bentley.

Cars must conform to BDC Motorsport Trophy Regulations.

BDC Class BA: Vintage WO Bentley – 3 litres

Derby Bentley – 3½ litre

BDC Class BB: Pre-war Vintage WO Bentley – 4½ litre

Pre-war Vintage WO Bentley – 3/4½ litre

Derby Bentley – 4¼ litre

Post-war Mk VI, R type, S1 - Standard

BDC Class BC: Pre-war Vintage WO Bentley – 6½ litre

Pre-war Vintage WO Bentley – 8 litres

Derby Bentley – V12

Post-war Mk VI, R type, S type - Modified

Class PW: Pre-War Cars, & Non-Bentley Drivers Club Members.

Awards: At fall of the chequered flag, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Overall.

At the end of the Race, competitors will receive the following:

Class BB, 30 Seconds will be added to their race time.

Class BC, 60 Seconds will be added to their race time.

Class PW, 90 Seconds will be added to their race time.

Awards: After Class Time added,

Class Awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Subject to 1, 3, and 7 starters per Class.

Event 2. BDC The John Duff Trophy & Frank Clement Cup,

Qualifying Time: 30Min, Race Distance: 30Min, Entry Fee: ~~£410~~ £430 for the race, Second Driver fee £25

The race is open to BDC Members and Non BDC Members competing in WO Bentley cars and continuation "period" cars.

The race is open for 1 or 2 drivers.

The John Duff Trophy will be awarded for the Scratch Winner.

The Frank Clement Cup will be awarded by Sealed Handicap.

There will be a compulsory pit stop between 10-minutes and 20-minutes of the 30-minute race time for the driver change. For a single driver entry, the driver must vacate the car, both feet on the ground, re enter the car and then continue.

For all driver changes, engines must be switched off whilst the driver change takes place.

Awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Subject to 1, 3, and 7 starters per Class.

Event 3: BDC Bentley Handicap (Pitlane Start)

Qualifying: Times used in any session on the day, Race Distance: 8Laps, Entry Fee: ~~£325~~ £340
Must be a BDC Member, driving a Bentley.
Cars must conform to current BDC Motorsport Trophy Regulations.
Awards, 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall.

Event 4. BDC Sports Car Challenge Race & Morgan Techniques Trophy Race

Qualifying Time: 15Min, Race Distance: 15Min, Entry Fee: ~~£325~~, £340
For 50s, 60s, 70s, Sports Cars up to 2500cc. running in 2 Classes,
Class H, Cars running on Dunlop R5, 56/CR48 L section or Dunlop R7/CR65 M
Class M, Cars running on Modern Road Tyres.
Entries will be taken at the discretion of the organisers within the spirit of the meeting.
Awards, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Subject to 1, 3, and 7 starters per Class.

Class TT, Morgan Techniques Trophy, Cars running to Trophy Regulations.
Awards, 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall

Event 5. Bentley Open Race & Allcomers Race

Qualifying Time: 15Min, Race Distance: 15Min, Entry Fee: ~~£325~~, £340
Must be a BDC Member, driving a Bentley.
Cars must conform to current BDC Motorsport Trophy Regulations.
Crewe Bentley Continental GT (excluding convertibles and GT3 racing cars).
Class BO: All other Bentleys not eligible for Group A, B or C.
Open formula may run with wings and slick tyres.
Awards, 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall.
Allcomers: Open to any member of an invited club.
Cars may run with wings and slick tyres.

If 5 or more cars of 1 type being entered, a single class will be formed,
All other cars will be entered into a Class by their practice times.
1 to 6 Class A1,
7 to 12 Class A2,
13 to 18 Class A3,
19 to 24 Class A4,
25 to 30 Class A5,
31 to 36 Class A6,
37 to 40 Class A7,

Event 6. AMOC St Horsfall Trophy.

Qualifying Time: 15Min, Race Distance: 15Min, Entry Fee: ~~£325~~, £340
Cars running to Challenge Regulations.
AMOC Sealed Handicap
BDC Awards, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Overall.

Event 7. Morgan Challenge.

Qualifying Time: 20Min, Race Distance: 2 x 20Min, Entry Fee: £525,
Cars running to Challenge Regulations.
BDC Awards, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Overall. Each Race.

Event 8. FISCAR Series.

Qualifying Time: 20Min Race Distance: 30Min Entry Fee: £395, Second Driver £25,
Cars running to Series Regulations.
BDC Awards, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Overall.

- 22) Competitors will be identified by numbers on each side of the car and on the bonnet/front of the car. If competitors have not received 6 Clerk of the Course signatures prior to this meeting, then they must carry a novice cross at the rear of their car as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'). If supplied, race sponsor's decals must be prominently displayed on competing cars as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'), H28. Failure to display or remove decals may result in a penalty. Competition numbers, backgrounds, symbols, and Novice Cross will be available on the day from Race Administration.
- 23) The Chief Scrutineer of the event and members of the Technical Commission are considered 'Judges of Fact' in respect of Vehicle Eligibility as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR').
- 24) Environmental Scrutineers in charge of "Sound Meters" are considered Judges of Fact in respect of Sound as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR').
- All cars will be checked for sound levels and must comply with the limits as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'), and any venue specific requirements.
- 25) The Chief Scrutineer and Officials in charge of the "Speed Gun" are considered 'Judges of Fact' in respect of Speed in the Pit Lane.
- 26) The Chief Timekeeper and Handicapper are considered as 'Judges of Fact' in respect of Timing and Laps Counted.
- 27) Each competitor is required to have a timing transponder as per ~~National Competition Rules V9~~ ('NCR'), which they will be required to fit to their car, in such a place that it can send an uninterrupted signal Vertically Downwards to the track. Transponders are available to hire for a non-BDC Member direct from TSL Timekeepers [Hire Shop](#).
BDC members can hire through the entry form FOC.
Competitors should be aware that any timekeeping device hired must be returned before leaving the circuit. In the event of said device being damaged, destroyed or not returned, the Competitor will be liable for any replacement costs. Your Competition Race Licence will be retained as security and given back to you on receipt of the returned transponder.
- 28) Pit Stop Regulations will be issued in Final Instructions or by Bulletin.
- 29) Upgrade cards may be signed at this meeting but must be left with the Secretary of The Meeting at Sign-on. The card must have a current photo and signed by the Competitor.

30) All competitors are required to uphold the standards of the Motorsport UK Race with Respect. Full details can be found via this link [Race with Respect - Motorsport UK](#)
