

Pit Stop Regulations.

BDC John Duff/Frank Clement Race V2

- (1) John Duff/Frank Clement:** Pit Stop Must Take place between Garages 1, Pit In and Garage 19, Pit Office.
- (2) Pit Stop for one or two drivers**
 - a)** During the **30**-minute race the pit lane will be open for the compulsory pit stop between **5** minutes and **25** minutes from the start of the race.
 - b)** Failure to comply with the pit open window period a competitor will be penalised by **being demoted 5 places on the race result sheet.**
 - c)** For a single driver entry, the driver must vacate the car, both feet on the ground, re enter the car and then continue.
 - d)** For all stops, engines must be switched off whilst the stop takes place.
 - e)** Failure to comply with the Pit Stop Regulations will result in penalties being applied of **5 places on the race result sheet** for each infringement unless a particular infringement has a specified penalty in these regulations or MSUK NCR V10.
 - f)** Judges of fact will be appointed to ensure compliance
- (3) No** refuelling in Qualifying or Race is allowed.
- (4)** In the event of a safety car being employed in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulations the pit lane exit will be closed until the train behind the safety car has passed.
- (5)** Any Car, that in its Pit Stop, is under 25 seconds from the Pit Entry Line to the Pit Exit Line measured by TSL Timekeepers will be deemed to have either Exceeding the Speed Limit or the Stationary Time.
Pit Entry Line to Pit Exit Line: 336mts, 20.1sec @ 60kph.
