## **Pit Stop Regulations FISCAR 2023**

## Race Organisers Standing Race Regulations will apply at this meeting.

## (2) Pit Stop for one or two drivers

- a) During the **30** minute race the pit lane will be open for the compulsory pit stop between **5** minutes and **25** minutes from the start of the race.
- b) Failure to comply with the pit open window period a competitor will be penalised by **being demoted 5 places on the race result sheet**.
- c) Competitors entering the Pit Lane for the Pit Stop must have seatbelts fully secured until the car has come to a complete halt.
- d) Competitors who are driving on their own can remain in the car but must remain stationary for **45 seconds\***.
- e) Competitors who are sharing a car must ensure that the seatbelts, if fitted, of the second driver are fully secured and the car must be stationary for a total time of 45\*seconds before leaving.
- f) Engines do not have to be switched off if there is no driver change. .
- g) Failure to comply with the Pit Stop Regulations will result in penalties being applied of **5 places on the race result sheet** for each infringement unless a particular infringement has a specified penalty in these regulations. (see 2b and 4).
- h) Judges of fact will be appointed to ensure compliance
- (3) **No** refuelling in the pits is allowed.
- (4) In the event of a safety car being employed in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulations the pit lane exit will be closed until the train behind the safety car has passed.

WARNING: The pit lane speed limit is 60 kph and will be enforced by the use of a speed gun and any speeding driver will be penalized by a drive through the pit lane!

\*Invitation car 55(Kellison J4R) will have a 75 second pit stop
